Sir John Eccles Vacation Scholarship

Undergraduate Science students have the opportunity to undertake 4-6 weeks work full time on a project within the Department of Anatomy and Cell Biology. Up to seven vacation scholarships are offered each year and they are worth \$1000 each. The work performed is not for credit and is not examined. The scholarship covers two areas, basic research or advanced dissection.

Selection for the scholarship is based on academic merit. The scholarships can be held for 4-6 weeks by arrangement with your supervisor. In the Sir John Eccles Basic Research Vacation Scholarship, the student will work in their supervisor's laboratory on the design, execution and analysis of a series of experiments. In the Sir John Eccles Advanced Dissection Vacation Scholarship, students will, under the direction of experienced topographic anatomists, prepare specimens to be used in subsequent teaching and anatomical workshops. It is important that a student first obtain the agreement of a supervisor before completing this form. The scholarship is tax free and will be paid as lump sum midway through your tenure. The applications will be considered during the second last week of Semester 1 and Semester 2 and successful candidates will be advised as soon as possible thereafter. The work would normally be done over the mid year or summer vacation. Further details are available on the Department web site.
